

## How can I fix my leaking private sewer?

You can either engage your own contractor or engage PUB to carry out the repair work.

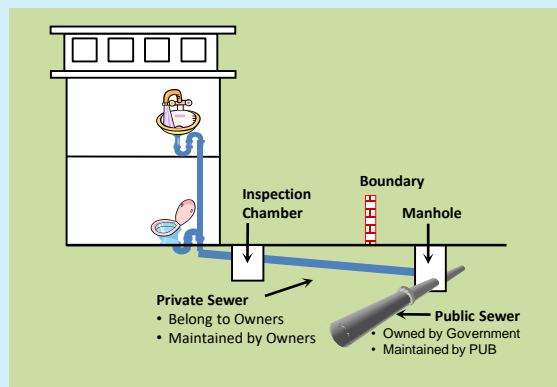

## Do I pay the full cost of the repairs ?

The government will pay part of the repair cost based on the proportion of your private sewer which lies beyond the boundaries of your property.

If you engage PUB, you will only need to pay for your share of the cost.

If you engage your own contractor, you will pay the contractor the total bill. PUB will then reimburse the amount due to you directly upon submission of proof of work to PUB that the repair work has been carried out satisfactorily.



## Do I need to fix all the private sewers?

To ensure that your entire private sewer system is leak-free, you are advised to check and repair all the lines that are found to be leaking.

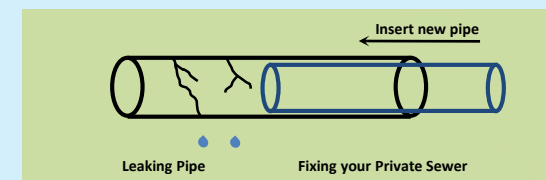
## Do I have to fix my private sewer immediately if it is leaking?

The repairs should be carried out **within 6 months** from the date of our Advisory Note.

## How long does it take to rehabilitate my private sewer?

A private sewer of up to 20m will not take more than 3 days to fix.

- Preparation work (includes pre-condition survey and cleaning)
- Lining work
- Post-lining work (inspection, water test)
- Waterproof coating of inspection chamber



## Will this affect the use of my toilets and kitchen?

Use of your toilets and kitchen generally will not be affected. In some cases, there may be a need for you to stop using the toilets for a short duration.

## How can I be sure that the work is properly carried out?

The contractor must provide you with a report as well as a closed circuit TV survey and / or leak test.

The contractor should also provide a warranty of at least one year.
